About Our School

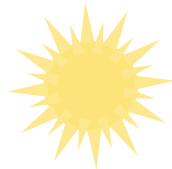
Nanny's Nest Nursery School is a fun place to learn and grow!

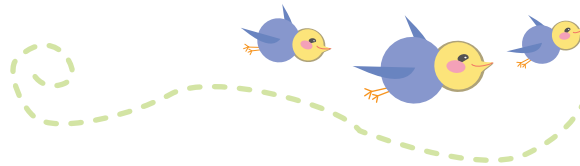

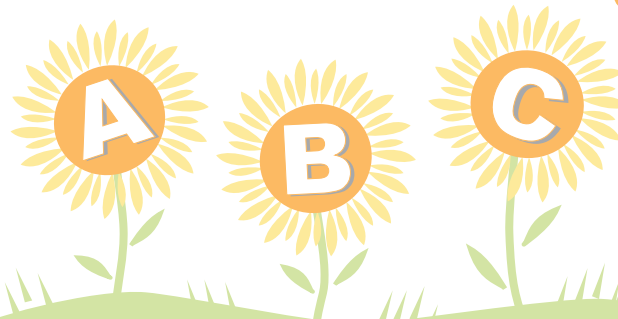
Tots for 2 ½ year olds

Nursery for 3 year olds

This class is offered to children who are 3 years old by September 30th. This class focuses on skills of interaction with other children, following directions, listening skills and being separated from parents into a loving environment. The curriculum involves language arts (Bible stories, show & tell, poems, songs, etc.), reading readiness, math readiness, manipulative activities (small motor activities), outdoor play (large motor activities), art projects and music. All of this takes place in a warm and loving atmosphere.



Pre-K for 4 year olds



This class is offered to children who are 4 years old by September 30th. This class focuses on kindergarten readiness. Listening skills, self-control, and increased confidence will improve as the children interact with the teachers and other children. The curriculum includes alphabet and number recognition (letter and number of the week), writing (name, letters and numbers), reading and math readiness, thematic units, Bible, outdoor play, art and music. All of the above is presented in a warm and loving atmosphere.

Transitional Kindergarten for 5 year olds



This class is designed for children who need an extra year before entering kindergarten. Children must turn 5 by September 30th. This is an enriched kindergarten readiness class. It includes extended math and reading readiness, social studies, science, music, art, physical education and Bible. Children are encouraged to become more independent with additional time spent on letters and letter sounds, rhyming, language expansion, following directions, math concepts and self-help skills. This class bridges the Pre-K and Kindergarten experience together in a loving environment.

Kindergarten Plus for Kindergartners

This class is designed to enhance the Kindergarten's day by offering a fun filled session enjoying lunch, art, socialization, outdoor play, story time, and much more.
